



## Aquia Harbour Preschool Covid-19 Agreement

The health and safety of our students and families are our greatest priorities. In the interest of limiting the opportunity for transmission of COVID-19 and/or any other illness to our school and community, Aquia Harbour Preschool has implemented the following policies. Please initial each item to acknowledge that you have read and understood the policy.

\_\_\_ 1. Masks must be worn by all persons while waiting in line to pick up or drop off your child. A physical distance of at least six feet should be maintained between families while waiting in line. Masks must also be worn when you or your child are in the building. We strongly encourage you to practice proper mask usage with your child. (Mask must fully cover the nose and chin, refrain from touching the mask, wear masks when in close quarters with other people, reusable masks must be consistently laundered, etc.)\*\*\*

\_\_\_ 2. Before entering the building, temperature of the student will be taken and recorded in a daily school log. If the student has a temperature of 100.4° F or more, they will be refused entry into the building. If a parent or guardian enters the building, they will also have their temperature taken.

\_\_\_ 3. Do not bring your student to school if they have symptoms such as cough, shortness of breath, loss of sense of smell/taste, or fever. If you knowingly drop off a student that is ill, you will be subject to review by the AHPS Board of Directors and risk possible dismissal from AHPS for the remainder of the school year.

\_\_\_ 4. If the parent or guardian and/or the student attending AHPS knowingly enters AHPS property with a confirmed case of COVID-19, you will be subject to review by the AHPS Board of Directors and risk possible dismissal from AHPS for the remainder of the school year.

\_\_\_ 5. If the student has been exposed to and subsequently tested for COVID-19, they must quarantine and wait until results of the test are obtained before returning to AHPS. You must immediately notify AHPS that the student has been tested. You must show proof of a negative COVID-19 test result before re-admission into the building.

\_\_\_\_ 6. If a parent, guardian, or immediately family member that resides with the student has been exposed to and tested positive for COVID-19, the student must be tested for COVID-19 and quarantine for a minimum of fourteen (14) days. You must immediately notify AHPS of the potential exposure. You must show proof of a negative COVID-19 test result before re-admission into the building.

\_\_\_\_ 7. Fourteen (14) days after the last potential exposure to COVID-19, your student may return to AHPS provided that it has been at least ten (10) days since any household members first experienced symptoms, symptoms have improved, and the household has been fever free for at least forty-eight (48) hours without any fever reducing medication.

\_\_\_\_ Aquia Harbour Preschool is required by the VA Department of Health (VDH) and VA Department of Social Services (VDSS) to report any cases of COVID-19, so it is imperative that you notify AHPS immediately of any exposure to COVID-19 and/or related (positive or negative) test results.

\*\*\*Please be aware that by signing the form below, I am acknowledging the potential risk of exposure to and possibly contraction COVID-19 during any time spent on the school premises. I do hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless and do hereby release Aquia Harbour Preschool and its officers, employees, and agents from any and all liability and risk associated with COVID-19.\*\*\*
